

# CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PETITION FORM

I am a registered voter of Florida and hereby petition the Secretary of State to place the following amendment to the Florida Constitution on the ballot in the general election:

**Ballot Title:**

Restoration of Voting Rights

**Ballot Summary:**

Revises current constitutional requirement regarding restoration of voting rights to provide for restoration of voting rights upon completion of sentence.

**Full Text:**

Article VI, Section 4 (a), Florida Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

(a) No person convicted of a felony, ~~or adjudicated in this or any other state to be mentally incompetent~~, shall be qualified to vote or hold office except upon completion of sentence until restoration of civil rights or removal of disability, ~~nor shall any person adjudicated in this or any other state to be mentally incompetent be qualified to vote or hold office until removal of disability.~~
